

hاتیis: Bathing-Barkley Dialect

Facilitator Notes

hiisitsi?i	Get in the water.
máaalsitma	The water is cold.
ćamaŋi	Keep quiet.
wikŋałši?ałi	Be quiet.
ćamaŋi hiisitałquuk	Keep quiet while you're in the water.

These phrases can be used while going into the lake, stream or ocean.

hاتیis describes any bathing that does not follow the strict protocols required of ?uusumč 'ritual bathing'. The term hاتیis does not exclude prayerful bathing.

The above phrases use singular command ending -i for speaking to one person. If speaking to more than one person, use the ending -ič.
