**Facilitator Notes** (nuučaañuᑭ in bold, *English notes in italics below*).

hišuk<sup>h</sup>wič ᑭačwaas - *Everybody look outside*

ᑭaaqinᑭ ᑭaasᑭii - *What is the day doing?*

*Responses (do an action that matches your phrase such as wiping sweat from your brow if it is hot, mimicking rainfall with your fingers etc.):*

ᑭupaaᑭiᑭ - *It is hot weather*

ᑭuuᑭuqukᑭiᑭ - *It is nice weather*

ᑭi<sup>h</sup>waᑭyuᑭiᑭ - *It is cloudy*

ᑭiᑭᑭaaᑭiᑭ - *It is raining*

ᑭiᑭᑭiᑭiᑭ - *It is raining off and on*

wiiqsiiᑭiᑭ - *It is stormy*

ᑭupaᑭᑭᑭiᑭ - *It is dark*

ᑭ<sup>h</sup>wisaaᑭiᑭ - *It is snowing*

ᑭacaa ᑭiᑭ - *It is hailing*

ᑭuuqumᑭiᑭiᑭ - *It is good weather (on the water)*

ᑭyuᑭiᑭiᑭ - *It is windy*

ᑭiᑭačiᑭᑭ - *The sea is stormy*

ᑭuuxᑭasᑭiᑭ - *It (the ground) is icy*

ᑭ<sup>h</sup>wimacyuᑭiᑭ - *It is frosty*

ᑭučqakᑭiᑭ - *It is foggy*
